BREIF SUMMARY OF ACADEMIC AND EMPLOYMENT HISTORY

i was graduated in 1970 from the faculty of engineering EIN SHAMS University, Cairo with a BSc degree in Mechanical Production Engineering.

almost immediately after graduation, I emigrated to England U.K where I stayed for fourteen (14) consecutive years to receive further education and gain engineering and industrial experience. Initially, I have joined Salford University to obtain advanced diploma in Production Engineering which I achieved with distinction grade in 1973. As a result I was awarded a university scholarship to conduct post graduate research leading to PhD degree and later I was a awarded the PhD. to start with, I have registered for an MSc degree in the department of mechanical and aeronautical engineering (research topic was design for production)later I was transferred to the PhD registration, after carrying out research work for 5 consolidated academic years at Salford University, I joined Mather & Platt co, Itd in 1977, which is a worldwide engineering firm, as a full time employee and moved within several posts until promoted to the middle east regional manager position, After 14 years residence in England, I found the opportunity to immigrate back to Egypt in 1984 to join the export development bank of Egypt and witness the unique opportunity of joining the establishment of a new national development bank. To support the new banking career I had to embark to different academic field of business administration so I had to take several new courses but most significant of which was the diploma in business administration through distance learning with Warwick University, Coventry U.K.

The career inside the bank was mainly in projects finance sector, which represented the bulk of the bank activity, I moved inside the finance sector until promoted to sector general manager in 1996, beside the main role inside the bank finance sector, I was given other assignments most important of which was to manage one of the bank companies to turn it around, I addition to working in England and in Egypt. I was involved in professional teaching and training subjects related to engineering and to business administration, finally I reached retirement in 2008.

In 2011, I have joined AL-WADI institute of technology, Cairo, and started a new career as a lecturer at faculty of engineering and I have been with AL-WADI since that time.

Almost one year, before the official inauguration of the bank, I joined a team of bank official economists and lawyers under the leadership of Doctor Hazem Biblawy chairman of the bank, to set the rules and procedures for the bank projects finance and promotion sector activity. This included establishing clients / company valuation procedures, project planning and evaluation, lending and finance rules risk assessment contract covenants etc. The bank officially started its finance and lending activity to clients In Feb. 1985, after official opening of the bank.

- Jan 1988 - manager of projects follow up dept. EDBE :

To take responsibility of bank follow up in lending activity ,project execution , loan disbursement and pay back and completion of bank legal documentation. Most important, the job responsibilities included processing of products, company operation and support clients in redirecting company activities to achieve success, as and when necessary.

To take full responsibility in, project finance and this included promoting and managing bank lending activities in projects finance, promotion and follow up.

Assignment necessitated the attendance in almost full time basis to run the technical, commercial and financial operation of the company for full re-engineering and Turn Around to make it suitable for resale.

the scope of the job included:

- 1- Locate a European strategic alliance to join company ownership; technology transfer and support in re-export company products to Europe.
- 2- Totally restructure company financial and capital structure to attract new partners / owners .
- 3- Locate local or foreign buyers to take major or minor part of company shares .

The assumed responsibilities of this post were to develop training programs for the bank department to upgrade staff capabilities.

The assumed responsibility of this post was to redevelop and re-establish new system documentation for the entire bank operation.
